MULTICULTURAL INFLUENCES

FLAVOURFUL TREASURES OF THE SEA

MUST-TRY SPECIALTIES

Martinique is full of excellent dining spots, from beachside snack stands to gourmet restaurants. A marathon of flavors. The discoveries begin at breakfast with the "Féroce": dried, grilled, crumbled cod mixed with manioc and avocado, or the "Ti nain morue," green banana cooked like a vegetable with dried cod. At cocktail hour, enjoy accras, blood sausages, and fried sauries. And don't miss the tasty "sauce chien" as an accompaniment to various dishes, prepared with chives, parsley, infused thyme, hot pepper, and garlic.

FORT-DE-FRANCE COVERED MARKET

Caribbean. Le Grand Marché Couvert, or Covered Market, is located in the heart of Fort-de-France. Designed by French architect Henri Picq and constructed in 1901, this bustling bazaar is where locals have bought and sold essential herbs, spices, produce, and other goods for generations. Visitors will find a variety of hand-crafted wooden bowls, traditional "bakoua" or straw hats, Creole dolls, and many homemade confectionaries that constitute an age-old tradition in Martinique.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES



GALERIE DE LA FONDATION CLÉMENT

In the southeastern town of Le François, Habitation Clément is a heritage site steeped in the culture of Martinique and its rum industry. Formerly a sugar plantation, this 160-hectare property features an 18th-century Creole house, an old distillery that has been converted into a museum, botanical gardens, and a contemporary art gallery.

MUSÉE FRANK PERRET, MÉMORIAL DE LA CATASTROPHE DE 1902

The Frank A. Perret museum commemorates the 1902 eruption of Mount Pelée, which destroyed the town of Saint-Pierre, with exhibits detailing this dramatic event that changed the history of Martinique. The oldest museum in Martinique, the building was renovated in 2018 and now boasts a striking contemporary design.

LA SAVANE DES ESCLAVES

Located in a sprawling park in Trois-Ilets, La Savane des Esclaves is an open-air museum dedicated to the history of Martinique. It features reconstructed indigenous and Creole villages along with exhibits detailing what life was like on the island during and after the slavery era. Visitors can also tour Creole and medicinal gardens.

THE JARDIN DE BALATA

This three-hectare park holds 3,000 types of indigenous flora and fauna—including some 300 species of palm trees—just outside of Martinique's capital. Follow the multilingual markers through Jean-Philippe Thoze's landscaped gardens, rolling green fields, and ponds dappled with water lilies and lotus flowers. The suspended paths and bridges provide an aerial view of the gardens.

THE TOMBOLO

A tombolo is a natural phenomenon in which the tide goes out and reveals a sandbar that connects the mainland to a neighbouring islet. This occurs spectacularly in Sainte-Marie, on Martinique's Atlantic coast, where the sandbar stretches more than 200 m to link Petite-Anse beach to the islet of Sainte-Marie. From November to April, the winds and ocean currents move the sand and alter the coastline, causing the tombolo to appear at the end of the year—and disappear four months later.
